



ACABM Fees and Funding

The course fee for the 2024 Advanced Course in Agricultural Business Management is £6,500.00 per delegate, this includes both the pre and post sessions as well as the two-week residential element at the Royal Agricultural University. All accommodation, meals and programme materials are also included.

Most delegates attending the course are either fully or partly funded by their employer, business, personally or through sponsorship.

All candidates selected for interview will need to indicate during the interview, how they intend to fund their attendance, if a place is offered. They will also need to be able to confirm to the panel that if one of the very limited number of places available is offered they are sufficiently confident of funding to be able to accept.

A deposit of £500.00 is payable once a candidate accepts a place offered on the course.

Advice regarding potential sources of grant funding, from both local and national organisations, is available through the RAU and/or the Worshipful Company of Farmers.
