## Rural Business Career Transition Course 2022

### Course Details

- This course is for members of the military community preparing for a follow-on career in rural business. Delegates will have the opportunity to examine how several food production, land management and sector retail businesses operate in order to apply learning on sector-specific business and management principles. Teaching will be conducted by industry specialist academics. Specific post-military career transition support will be integrated into the programme.
- The course will be two weeks fully residential at the Royal Agricultural University in Cirencester from 6<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
- The online learning resource for the course will be available for two weeks prior. Delegates will be asked to prepare a short brief on a relevant subject to present to their fellow attendees during the initial two days of the residential course.
- Participation in the course requires commitment to full attendance of the full two-week residential programme. (The course breaks at the weekend and restarts on the Monday of week two. You are encouraged to stay local for the duration of the course, perhaps taking the weekend as an opportunity for family/friends to join you and to explore some of the many activities and points of interest which surround Cirencester. In addition, during the week there will be 2-3 dinner events to attend.)

### Course Costs

The course fee for 2022 is £2,400 incl. VAT

Accommodation and Full Board is available on campus at a special rate of £1,200 including VAT (to be paid in full prior to arrival, subsistence element will be itemised on the invoice).
