The University generates its income from a number of sources:

Total Income £18.155 million

Tuition fees and education contracts: £10.4m

Other (commercial) income: **£4.1m**

Funding body grants: £2.7m

Farming income: £0.6m

Research grants and contracts: £0.3m

The surplus of income over expenditure in year provides the University with funds that it can reinvest in new services and facilities:






Surplus 2013/14: £0.3 million
