PREVENT is a government initiative set up to protect students from across the UK of all ages from terrorism, extremism and radicalisation. The RAU have set up their own PREVENT committee to ensure our students are not at risk and to make sure all students are presented with balanced views and arguments on all topics brought forward in lectures, by external visitors and beyond. As stated by Safe Campus Communities, PREVENT will:

- Respond to the ideological challenge of terrorism and the threat faced by the UK from those who promote it
- Prevent people from being drawn into terrorism and ensure they are given appropriate advice and support
- Work with a wide range of sectors (including education, criminal justice, faith, charities, the internet and health) where there are risks of radicalisation which need to be addressed
