Enter the University from the A419, Cirencester to Stroud Road. Limited free parking is available in the visitor area of main car park. On arrival please report to **Porters Lodge** to register and collect your room keys. This is located past the Boutflour Hall and the Chapel and is open from **8.00am** until **8.00pm**. For same day cancellations or late arrivals please notify the Porters Lodge on 01285 65253.

Rooms

Rooms will be available from **3:00pm** onwards on your arrival day (please be advised that rooms and keys cannot be released prior to this time) and will need to be vacated by **10:00am** on the day of departure.

Bedrooms available during term time are equipped with tea and coffee making facilities and rooms are serviced daily.
